

**Medical Association of Georgia (MAG) and American Medical Association (AMA)
Accreditation and Credit Designation Statement Examples**

Example statement for a directly provided live activity (1 AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™ or less):

The Southern Alliance for Physician Specialties CME is accredited by the Medical Association of Georgia to provide continuing medical education for physicians.

The Southern Alliance for Physician Specialties CME designates this live activity for a maximum of 1 *AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™*. Physicians should claim only the credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.

Example statement for a jointly provided live activity (1 AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™ or less):

This activity has been planned and implemented in accordance with the accreditation requirements and policies of the Medical Association of Georgia through the joint providership of Southern Alliance for Physician Specialties CME and [Insert Organization Name]. The Southern Alliance for Physician Specialties CME is accredited by the Medical Association of Georgia to provide continuing medical education for physicians.

The Southern Alliance for Physician Specialties CME designates this live activity for a maximum of 1 *AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™*. Physicians should claim only the credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.

Example statement for a directly provided live activity (more than 1 AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™):

The Southern Alliance for Physician Specialties CME is accredited by the Medical Association of Georgia to provide continuing medical education for physicians.

The Southern Alliance for Physician Specialties CME designates this live activity for a maximum of 1.25 *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™*. Physicians should claim only the credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.

Example statement for a jointly provided live activity (more than 1 AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™):

This activity has been planned and implemented in accordance with the accreditation requirements and policies of the Medical Association of Georgia through the joint providership of Southern Alliance for Physician Specialties CME and [Insert Organization Name]. The Southern Alliance for Physician Specialties CME is accredited by the Medical Association of Georgia to provide continuing medical education for physicians.

The Southern Alliance for Physician Specialties CME designates this live activity for a maximum of 1.25 *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™*. Physicians should claim only the credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.

MAG/AMA NOTES

The accreditation and credit designation statement must appear on all CME activity materials and brochures distributed by accredited organizations, except the statements do not need to be included on initial, save-the-date type activity announcement. Such announcements contain only general, preliminary information about the activity such as the date, location and title. If more specific information is included, such as faculty and objectives, the accreditation and credit designation statements must be included.

Learning formats include: live activity, enduring material, journal-based CME activity, test-item writing activity, manuscript review activity, PI CME activity and Internet point-of-care activity. CME providers may designate an activity format as other if it does not fall into one of the established format categories, without asking permission from MAG/AMA.
