3 MONTH FOLLOW-UP

Educational Activity Evaluation

SAPS CME requires that all educational activities be evaluated by the attendees. The evaluation need not be exhaustive but must include some questions that will help the planners determine if the activity was effective and also ways that they can improve for future activities.

Every CME activity must measure **Performance Outcomes**. Most SAPS CME activities are measured with a post-activity evaluation. The questionnaire is sent to activity attendees 3 months after the conclusion of the activity. For performance outcomes, you are seeking information on changes that have already been implemented in practice since attending the activity. The Performance Outcomes can best be measured by sending out the below short 3-question follow-up survey. We suggest using Survey Monkey. Your questions can be similar to these:
